- Show/Hide Pages Toggle the display of pages in the preview window. Disabling the display of pages enable operators to easily check the mark placement.
- Show/Hide Grid Lines Toggle the display of grid lines in the preview window.
- Application of single or multiple creep values to all or different signature. This handles single or multiple types of paper to be used in the same publication
- Filter functions are now provided to make it easier and quicker to locate the signature required.
- The new multiple pages per sheet function will allow user to place multiple signatures on any given sheet size, this will help to meet certain print requirement, increasing productivity.







First we eliminate user login but depends on the work station that the user has logged in at the time. We introduce a group concept that will allow users in the same group to work on the same job. If user is logged in formally then it can only work on the job he has specified.




Pages and grid lines hidden allowing operators to clearly check the mark and label placement




Collating Collating Mark #1 Mark #2
